NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A VARIATION A PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is given that Wattsville Community Group have on the 26th April 2021 applied to Caerphilly County Borough Council, as the Licensing Authority, for a variation of a premises licence in respect of The Sports Ground Pavilion, Wattsville Recreational Ground Of: Islwyn Road, South Lane, Wattsville, Gwent, NP11 7QH

It is proposed to

- Vary the licensing hours for the sale of alcohol and playing of recorded music Mon to Sat 12:00 to 23:00 & Sun 12:00 to 22:00 with additional non-standard timings for NYE & Bank holidays
- Include the licensing area to cover the external compound area to the rear of the building as per attached plans.
- Amend existing condition to include additional CCTV cameras to the external areas of the premises.
- Add live music between the hours 12:00 to 23:00 Monday to Sunday.
