The provision of recorded music (indoors and outdoors) on the following days: Monday to Sunday 12:00 to 24:00

The provision of performances of dance (indoors) on the following days: Monday to Sunday 09:00 to 24:00.

The supply of alcohol on the premises on the following days: Monday to Sunday 10:00 to 01:00
