NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is given that I/we, Cadw/Welsh Government have on the 10/01/25 applied to Caerphilly County Borough Council, as the Licensing Authority, for a variation of a premises licence in respect of the Great Hall, Caerphilly Castle, of Castle Street, Caerphilly, CF83 1JD.

It is proposed to include the area known as the Great Hall and Earls Apartments with marquee, into the existing premises licence for licensable activities.
