NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is given that I, Newbridge Rugby Football Club have on the April 28th, 2026 applied to Caerphilly County Borough Council, as the Licensing Authority, for a premises licence in respect of Ground Floor, Lower Ground Floor, Terracing and Field at Newbridge RFC of Newbridge RFC, The Clubhouse, Bridge Street, Newbridge, NP11 5FR.

It is proposed to: Licence the premises for provision of plays, films, indoor sporting events, boxing or wrestling entertainments, live & recorded music, performances of dance and anything similar to live & recorded music and performances of dance.

Also the provision of late night refreshment and the supply of alcohol.

These licensable activities will take place within the hours that the premises is open to the public which are: Monday – Thursday 9am – 12:30am.

Friday - Sunday 9am - 1.30am.
